NEW HOMEOWNERS NEEDING AMENITY CARDS

Welcome to Riverstone! To have amenity cards made for you, please email us the following:

1. Completed amenity card form (found at www.riverstone.com)
2. Deed or closing disclosure

3. Individual headshot pictures of each resident over the age of 5. Please label each photo with their name and date of birth.

4. Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18.

5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.

REPLACING A LOST AMENITY CARD

The replacement of lost Amenity Cards is available for \$15 each.

If you need a replacement Amenity Card, please complete the credit card form found on our website (www.riverstone.com) and email it to us at customercare@riverstone.com. Please also include your home address and a headshot picture labeled with your name and date of birth.

HOA CORNER

Property Modifications

MUST BE APPROVED PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

In order to protect the high esthetic value that Riverstone is known for, property owners need to submit a Modification application for review prior to starting any work on any exterior improvements. This process is not in place to burden or cause stress to any homeowner but rather to allow the Association to keep records of work done to properties, ensure that approved guidelines are followed, as well as help maintain Riverstone's property values. If an owner has completed a modification(s) without getting prior approval, the Association recommends still submitting an application for approval. Riverstone's governing documents require that each property sale has a completed Certificate of Compliance (COC) performed by the Association, and unfortunately, when unapproved modifications are discovered during this process, it can cause challenges and possible delays in the sale process. Please make sure that all modifications are approved in advance, which will save homeowners time and stress during the COC process. Below is a general summary of a few of the common improvements that should be applied for, how to apply, and the process. For a full list of all modification guidelines, please visit www.riverstone.com.

LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS

A Modification Application and approval is required if you plan to change the landscaping, or general design of the yard. For example, if you intend to make significant changes in size, elevation, and types of shrubs in planting beds, significant changes to or the addition of landscape borders, or plan to remove or change turf, you need to submit in advance and follow the Association's adopted guidelines. It is also very important for homeowners to apply for modifications, in advance, if you plan to remove or plant any trees or wish to remove or change the location of any builder-installed plantings. We often discover owners have removed trees without approval, and we want to avoid this being done in a manner that does not adhere to the community requirements. This will allow the owner to avoid possibly incurring additional expenses to bring the property back into compliance with the guidelines. The Association recognizes that there are situations in which tree removals and landscape



modifications are necessary, and we want to work with owners to make the modification approval process proceed as smoothly as possible.

FENCING/ROOF/OTHER EXTERIOR MODIFICATIONS

When making repairs to fencing, roofs, or the repairing of components on the exterior of the home, a Modification Application and approval is necessary if you are simply replacing or repairing with the same materials, same color, and same design. If you are changing any of these with a different style, color, type, or material, you need to submit in advance. We frequently discover that owners have replaced fencing with unapproved types of fencing (type of wood, wrong color, stain, wrong design/style), and this can be a costly mistake to have to return the project to an approvable condition. Please do not rely on your contractor to determine if it is an approvable replacement or repair - many contractors will tell you it will be fine, and the repair is not per the guidelines.

MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS

A Modification Application and approval are required for any major improvements such as pools, outdoor kitchens, sports courts, or room additions. Please note that major modifications will require a deposit that will be refunded on completion of a modification inspection after the work has been completed and if the project was done according to the approved application. Major projects also require all supplemental information, such as lot surveys/plats, pictures, professional drawings/plans, samples, etc., on the project to be fully completed and submitted for the project to be reviewed by the ARC. Filling out the application in its entirety with all requested documents can prevent any delays or denials due to missing information.

After an application is submitted, it will be reviewed by a committee, which meets monthly and is composed of resident volunteers. Once a decision has been reached, the owner will receive either an approval, an approval with conditions, or a denial.

Riverstone Community Mobile Access

Shaking your phone is no longer required. Please be sure to update to the latest version in the Google Play and Apple App Store.

- To Utilize your new MyID , follow steps 1 and 2. To open an access point, use step 3.
- Open your Riverstone app, and select the MyID icon in the upper right of the Home Feed.
- Toggle the switch beside Tap to Send Mobile Access Credential to ON (green).
- To access a door, open your Riverstone app and Tap MyID
- Please be sure to allow all permissions if prompted by your mobile device.

Tree Topping

Many people think that you can shorten a tree by cutting off the top. What they don't realize is that topping permanently disfigures and damages the tree and may even kill it. How does topping hurt trees? Topping damages trees by removing much of the leaf surface area needed to produce food and food storage reserves. It leaves large wounds that are slow to heal and become entry points for insects and disease organisms. Finally, it allows strong sunlight to enter the central parts of the tree, resulting in sunscald, cracks, and peeling bark. Tree topping is not the proper way to maintain trees and, therefore, is considered a violation of the Riverstone restrictions. Please note that you may be required to replace trees that have been topped.

Fitness Center Etiquette Continued

With spring finally here, you may be planning to visit the Riverstone Fitness Center in preparation for swimsuit season and the upcoming summer months. Everyone, occasionally, needs a friendly reminder about gym etiquette to respect others' space, time, and Fitness Center rules. Rules such as:

- Residents who are 14 years of age or older and have a valid Riverstone ID card may use the Fitness Center.
- Permitted users may not move equipment from its designated area or remove equipment from the Fitness Center. Permitted Users may only use equipment in the Fitness Center; no outside weights or apparatuses may be brought into or used in the Fitness Center.
- All equipment must be wiped down after use with wipes and spray provided.



- Abuse of Equipment, unsportsmanlike conduct, or failure to comply with these rules may result in expulsion from the Fitness Center and possible suspension of the right to use the fitness center in the future, as determined in the sole discretion of the Association.

Business Spotlight

Swimming lessons can provide children with valuable life skills and help with their physical development. Riverstone residents seeking the most professional swimming instruction services turn to Blue Legend Swim School.



Riverstone residents Jing Li and Michael Yang opened the school in 2014. Originally, they rented facilities in schools and gyms and acquired their first indoor pools in 2020. That led to the establishment of two campuses, one in Sugar Land and one in Katy. Both campus swimming pools are 25-yard heated, standard

pools. The Sugar Land campus also has a 9-foot-deep section used to train advanced students and the artistic swimming team.

Jing was a professional synchronized swimmer who represented the national team in competitions, taking home seven championship titles. Michael graduated with a master's degree in Sports Management from George Washington University. He is a professional sports agent and manager, has worked in the NBA and has extensive management experience in youth sports training. It was their combined experience that ultimately made them decide to open Blue Legend, which quickly attracted hundreds of students.

"In the early stages of our business, when we were still renting facilities, our student count had already reached several hundred," Jing said. "Due to the limited space available in the rented facilities, our waiting list extended up to six months, and the number of students continued to grow. It was because of this that we decided to build our own swimming pools, allowing us to provide swim lessons to more students."

Today, each campus can hold up to 12 classes per hour. There are 60 total instructors between the two campuses. All coaches are required to have more than three years of professional swimming team experience, as well as more than one year of teaching experience. Additionally, they have several world champion coaches and retired national team athletes, which provides a solid foundation for professional swim instruction.

"We don't just offer 'fun' classes," Li said. "We aim to teach students with professional standard techniques from the very beginning, so they don't develop bad swimming habits that later need to be corrected. I believe every parent and child who comes to our school has high expectations of us, and I don't want to disappoint them."

Classes include a 30-minute swim safety course for children aged 4 months to 4 years, swimming posture courses for those older than 4 years and a professional swim team course. They also offer adult classes.



"We are extremely proud to offer artistic swimming classes as well, in which some of our athletes have won several national championships," Li said. "Our Blue Legend Artistic Swimming Club also represented the United States

at the Pan American Championship last year. We won four gold medals among 12 countries, which is the best result in more than a decade, and we are very proud of this achievement."

Li said that children learn valuable skills when they learn to swim.

"Not only does learning how to swim help keep children safe when around a pool or waterway, it can also provide many other benefits such as improved sleep and enhanced endurance," she said. "Some personal development areas in children that are impacted by taking swimming lessons include cognitive, emotional and social development."



Research has shown that children who attend swimming classes develop better logic and problem-solving skills. Swimming lessons also allow children to interact with other children and adults which helps them develop necessary social and emotional skills.

"I believe that learning to swim teaches children more about life perspectives," Li said. "They encounter challenges and persist through rigorous training, ultimately overcoming their difficulties and achieving results. This teaches them that, no matter what difficulties or challenges life may present, one should never give up easily."

Blue Legend offers a free 30-minute trial swimming lesson for both children and adults.

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

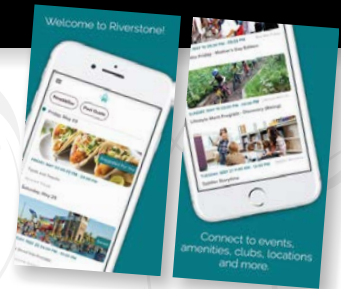
