NEW HOMEOWNERS NEEDING AMENITY CARDS

Welcome to Riverstone! To have amenity cards made for you, please email us the following:

1. Completed amenity card form (found at www.riverstone.com)
2. Deed or closing disclosure

3. Individual headshot pictures of each resident over the age of 5. Please label each photo with their name and date of birth.
4. Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18.
5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.

REPLACING A LOST AMENITY CARD

The replacement of lost Amenity Cards is available for \$15 each.

If you need a replacement Amenity Card, please complete the credit card form found on our website (www.riverstone.com) and email it to us at customercare@riverstone.com. Please also include your home address and a headshot picture labeled with your name and date of birth.

Printed Amenity Cards are available via no-contact pick up at our office, or can be mailed to your home.

Have You Received Your Annual Assessment?

The annual Riverstone HOA assessments have been mailed to owners. If you have not received your assessment statement, please contact the Association Office at 281.778.2222. You can also view your account and assessment information on our Resident Account Portal (www.riverstone.com). Assessment Payments are due January 1, 2025 and are considered delinquent after January 31, 2025. A brochure with payment options and instructions was included in your statement, and information is available on our website. Please note that payments are posted to your account on the date received, NOT the postmarked date. Please be sure to pay your assessments on time to avoid payment plan fees, late fees, and/or interest. Please email finance@riverstone.com with any questions.

Assessment FAQs

Do I need to create an account to pay online?

Yes. You must be logged in to our Resident Account Portal to make your online payment.

Is there a fee to pay online?

It depends. There is no fee to pay by eCheck. If you pay by credit card, there is a 3% convenience fee. If paying by debit card, there is a \$5.00 fee.

Can I mail a check?

Yes. Checks should be made payable to and mailed to: Riverstone Homeowners Association Inc. PO Box 94104 Las Vegas, NV 89193-4104.

Where do I find my Management Co ID, Association ID, and User Account Number?

The Management Co ID is 7214.

The Association ID is R100.

The User Account Number is the 10-digit set of numbers starting with 1004 located in the top right box on your statement

Are there payment plan options?

Absolutely! Residents can opt for a 3-to-6-month payment plan without accruing Interest Charges or Late Fees. There is a \$20 per month Administrative and Processing Fee. Please contact finance@riverstone.com for more information.

Calling All Volunteers

Annually, the Riverstone HOA Board appoints resident volunteers as members on various committees that have been created specifically geared towards different areas of interest. A few current committees include the Landscaping Committee and the Modification Sub Committee.

Modification Sub Committee—This committee is responsible for reviewing applications related to modifications of residential properties and will help develop policies/guidelines for the community.

Landscape Committee—Residents serving on this committee shall assist in identifying landscaping-related projects, as needed. They shall coordinate yard of the month and annual holiday decorating contest, as well as, help HOA staff identify areas that may not accurately reflect the pride of this community (i.e., littering) and work with HOA staff to brainstorm and implement ideas that promote taking pride in our community.

Foundation Committee—This committee works alongside the HOA Staff and Board to review grant applications and select projects and programs believed to best reflect the needs and interests of the

community. Foundation fees are primarily used to fund community events, health and wellness, technology, education, the environment, and enhancements to infrastructure within the community.

Gated Neighborhood Committees—Responsible for recommending service levels and providing input on reserve projects for their respective Gated Neighborhood (such as gate operations, landscaping, camera systems, etc.). They also provide input on annual Gated Neighborhood Assessment levels and annual budgets.

Finance Committee—This committee will Work alongside the HOA Staff and Board to review short and long-term investments of Riverstone HOA funds, Riverstone’s HOA Annual Operating Budget, capital requirements, reserve studies, and insurance coverage.

Compliance Reminders

Riverstone Compliance Department encourages all residents to take a few minutes and look over their property for any potential deed restriction issue that may result in a violation.

Here are some helpful reminders:

- Any landscape modifications or additions to the front or rear yard require approval from the MSC.
- Please trim trees over the sidewalk and street so that it does not impact pedestrians and vehicles or block street signs.
- Remember to remove weeds from your landscaping beds and tree wells and to treat your lawn for weeds.



- Keep your trash and recycle bin out of public view on non-trash days. This includes any trash bags.
- Remove trees stakes if they are over 1 year old.
- Please do not park vehicles to block the sidewalk.
- Remove any dirt and/or mildew on the outside of the house.
- Portable basketball goals are not permitted in the front yard. They are permitted in the backyard of non-view lots but must receive MSC approval.
- Please pick up after your pets.

January–February—Optimal time to replace or plant new trees and/or landscaping. Use preemergent weed control if needed. Treat for fire ants. Fertilize with slow-release product as needed.



Apply Before You Modify

Did Santa bring a new basketball goal or playset? Or do you want to add to your house, or build a new shed, or fence in your backyard? Before you break out the miter saw, make sure you get your plans approved by Riverstone Homeowners Association's Modification Sub Committee.

While it may seem arbitrary from an individual homeowners' standpoint, the Modification Sub Committee (MSC) looks out for the entire community. Aside from stopping residents from painting pink polka dots on their houses, the committee's job is to make sure that the size and style of the project, the type of building materials being used, and the overall look of the new structure adhere to the Association's design requirements. Not only does this keep the community looking cohesive, it also helps to keep property values up by preventing individual structures from standing out. It's also important to note that unapproved modifications might legally have to be removed at the owner's expense, so save yourself money and headaches by getting it approved first!

With a presence in over 160 countries, Heartfulness offers an inclusive, non-sectarian space for anyone looking to explore their inner self. All programs and offerings from Heartfulness are free of cost.

"Heartfulness, a simple and subtle meditation practice, connects us with the light and love in our hearts," said Sushma Mani, a volunteer with the organization. "Through our network of thousands of global HeartSpots and one magnificent smartphone app, we offer the world a daily practice that awakens our potential for a simple, joyful existence."

Heartfulness relaxation and meditation techniques are studied and proven effective in reducing stress and anxiety, improving sleep, enhancing emotional intelligence, and exploring the heights and depths of human consciousness.

Sessions are held in centers throughout the Houston area. They provide services such as meditation sessions, wellness programs and community events conducted by certified trainers and volunteers.

Heartfulness had its first booth and information session in March 2024 at the Riverstone Wellness Fair. This was followed by an introductory relaxation and meditation session for the HOA office staff.

"We had a fantastic response at the Wellness Fair and the HOA office event," said Vaishali Bansal, one of the session coordinators, "As a result, we could offer relaxation and meditation sessions for residents and the Club55 group starting in April 2024 and will continue to offer ongoing sessions. These monthly hour-long sessions will include an introduction to the Heartfulness practice, guided relaxation, meditation and a question-and-answer segment."

Heartfulness involves four daily practices: relaxation, meditation on the heart, cleaning technique and prayer.

"Heartfulness Meditation is a simple, heart-centered practice designed to bring stillness to the mind, peace to the heart and balance to life," said Badri Mani, a Heartfulness meditation trainer. "It helps individuals connect with their inner self through meditation, fostering calmness and clarity in their everyday lives."

Heartfulness is powered by the dedication of volunteers who bring their enthusiasm and warmth to every session and event.



"Volunteers are essential to advancing the mission of Heartfulness," said volunteer Krishna Adluru. "They coordinate and oversee meditation sessions and events, guaranteeing seamless execution while offering participants a rewarding and meaningful experience."

Heartfulness sessions are offered at The Club at Riverstone from 10 to 11 a.m. every second Saturday of the month.

Vaishali Bansal noted the positive impact the sessions have had on participants.

"The meditation sessions have been very well-received by attendees," she said. "We've observed consistent attendance, reflecting their engagement and appreciation for the practice. Many participants have also expressed a growing awareness and interest in deepening their meditation experience."

Sushma Mani said that in addition to meditation sessions, Heartfulness organizes several community events for the residents to participate in. These include the annual Peace Day event in Sugar Land and various other opportunities to deepen their meditation practice through workshops and practice groups.

"Heartfulness goes beyond relaxation, offering practical tools for personal growth, emotional resilience, and a deeper connection with oneself and others," she said. "Its simplicity and accessibility make it a practice that anyone regardless of their background or experience, can embrace and benefit from. By empowering individuals to unlock their potential, Heartfulness cultivates a more harmonious and meaningful life. Being part of this transformative journey and witnessing its positive effects on individuals and communities is both inspiring and deeply rewarding. This tool is crafted to provide us with serenity in the midst of our hectic lives. It serves as an ideal meditation aid for all of us who juggle multiple tasks."

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.
- Parking for use of Tennis Courts 9 & 10 is at the Riverstone Blvd Recreation Center. Please refrain from parking within the Parkside neighborhood.
