Riverstone HOA Transition & Call for Candidates

Dear Homeowners of Riverstone,

As we move forward into an exciting new phase for our community, we want to inform you about important changes regarding the governance of the Riverstone Homeowners Association (HOA). Johnson Development Corporation (JDC), the developer of Riverstone, will soon be transitioning out of its role in the HOA Board. This transition marks a significant shift to a Board comprised entirely of residentelected positions.

Since the JDC ownership entities have transferred title of all sellable property within the boundaries of Riverstone, the Board will be filled by property owners in good standing within our association. This transition will enable you, the homeowners, to have a direct hand in electing Board members who will serve on your behalf. The newly elected Board members will assume responsibilities, including policymaking, planning, and overseeing the Riverstone Management Team, which manages the daily operations of our community. To ensure a fair and transparent election process, we will engage a third-party company to handle the tabulation of results. This will guarantee that no member of the Riverstone HOA board or Management Team is involved in verifying or counting the votes.

Compliance Updates & Reminders

The Riverstone Compliance team will not be citing deed restriction violations related to storm debris or damage until September. This will give adequate time for the removal of storm debris and hope-fully give residents with damage to roofs, fencing, and trees time to begin/make repairs.

If your property incurred damage during the storm and you anticipate repairs to continue past September 15th, 2024, please contact the compliance department via email at compliance@riverstone.com so that staff can work with you during this recovery process.

However, The Compliance team will continue to monitor violations documented pre-Beryl for compliance. To this end, the Compliance Coordinators will conduct their regular drive schedule for deed restriction violations unrelated to storm damage.

Why is tree trimming important?

Regular trimming is essential for the overall health of trees. By removing dead, diseased, or damaged branches, you help prevent the spread of disease and pests. Trimming also encourages new growth and allows for better air circulation and sunlight penetration, which are vital for a tree's vitality. Proper pruning can help shape the tree and ensure it grows in a balanced and healthy manner.

Well-trimmed trees can enhance the visual appeal of your landscape. They can create a tidy and attractive environment and help improve curb appeal. Proper pruning can also highlight the natural beauty of the tree and ensure it complements the overall landscape design. Plus, trimming of trees will help to not block street signs, impact roadway traffic, or interfere with pedestrians on sidewalks, which could lead to a notice being sent if the tree is not maintained properly.

The Riverstone Compliance Department encourages all residents to take a few minutes and look over their property for any potential Deed Restriction issue that may result in a violation.

Compliance Reminders:

- 1. Trash/Recycle bins and lawn bags need to be placed out of public view on non-trash days. All trash must be placed in an appropriate trash container per the deed restrictions.
- 2. Remember to mow, weed, and edge your lawn as needed, which may include on a weekly basis during the summer months.
- 3. Remove weeds from the landscaping beds and tree wells, and treat your yard as needed to control weeds.
- 4. Remove any dirt and/or mildew from the property. Pressure wash driveways and sidewalks to remove dirt and/or stains and trim trees over sidewalks and roads.
- 5. Any modifications to the outside of the property, including the backyard, requires an ARC approval. Please make sure to submit the ARC application for review prior to any work being done. 
Sheriff's Corner

The 4-1-1 on 9-1-1

Dispatch is the critical link in emergency response. Understanding when to dial 9-1-1 can be crucial. Fort Bend County Telecommunications Officer Krysten Rice discusses the role of a dispatcher and offers advice on how and when to speak with a dispatcher and the options you have to do so.

Q&A with TCO 3 Krysten Rice:

- Q: How do dispatchers serve our community?
- A: We provide police, fire and medical services to the county so anytime someone contacts 9-1-1 or they contact us on a non-emergency situation we have a protocol that we follow with certain questions depending on the issue they are having, up to giving lifesaving CPR instructions.
- Q: What is the difference between the non-emergency line, 281.341.4665, and 9-1-1?
- A: The non-emergency line is for any situation where police are needed, such as a crash scene, to report a crime that has occurred, to help locate missing persons, or to report a disturbance. The 911 line is for life-threatening emergencies involving violent crime in progress, a medical emergency, or fire.
- Q: What is the most important information to give to the dispatcher when calling 9-1-1?
- A: The very first thing is the location, we do want to know what is happening but we don't need the whole story first we need to know where we are going first.
- Q: When should Fort Bend County residents text 9-1-1 rather than calling?



- A: Situations where the caller may not be able to speak. Domestic violence situations, or if someone breaks into your home because the last thing you want to do is be talking on the phone.
- Q: What advice do you have for the callers to effectively communicate with a dispatcher?
- A: Know once the address is given to us we are immediately dispatching services. Just because we are continuing to ask you questions doesn't mean that it is taking longer. Effectively answering our questions will better help our fire department, medics, and police officers understand what they are getting into.

There are many types of martial art disciplines. One gaining increasing popularity is Brazilian jiu jitsu (BJJ), a self-defense discipline that emphasizes technique over strength, competitive opportunities and mental and physical benefits such as full-body workouts and strategic thinking. Where do you start? Renzo Gracie Riverstone.

The studio is one of 12 Renzo Gracie facilities located in Texas. The studio opened in 2020 and has attracted quite a following.

Additionally, BJJ encourages problem-solving and critical thinking, fostering mental resilience and emotional intelligence in young practitioners."

Classes for adults and children are supportive and inclusive with instructors offering individualized attention. Each student is encouraged to learn and grow at their own pace. Marvin said that many clients love the camaraderie and sense of community that they experience while training at the studio. Additional benefits include lowering stress and anxiety, weight loss, strengthening and conditioning the body.







Marvin said that what is most important is that the studio is dedicated to providing a safe and welcoming space for individuals of all ages and skill levels to explore the art of Brazilian jiu-jitsu.

"Our focus is on fostering a positive learning environment where students can develop both physically and mentally while build-



ing confidence and self-esteem," he said. "We prioritize individualized instruction, community engagement and a commitment to personal growth in every class."

Renzo Gracie Riverstone occupies a gorgeous 2,000-square-foot facility at 18734 University Boulevard. Training sessions are always supervised, with CPR-trained personnel on duty during every class. - Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.
